Grade 12 Parent Primer

My child is in grade 12...he's graduating, right?

- Sure (hope springs eternal, right?)
 - Students who <u>did not</u> have 10 credits as of June 2021 are not eligible to graduate in 2022.
 - This year, if a student is registered in a grade 12 homeroom, they are eligible to graduate.
 - Contact Guidance if you are unsure.

So long as they have 10 courses, they CAN graduate, right?

- Yes, they can.
- Guidance and administration are <u>required</u> to place students on track to graduate on time, even if that means they have to take courses they don't want.

So long as they have 10 credits, they WILL graduate, right??

- Not necessarily
 - Students who do not pass all their courses in the first semester may no longer be eligible to graduate in June.
 - Administration and/or guidance will be in touch with families when this happens.
 - Students who do not pass all the required courses in June will not graduate.

A note from staff

- Over the last two years, students have been faced with adversity, and the response has been to modify expectations, deadlines, etc.
- As we move through this year, we expect students to do their assignments on time.
- Zeros ARE possible and they are being entered fast and furiously at this point.
- Several students are on track to NOT graduate at this point.....
