Course Request Process

As has been our practice in the past, students will receive information from guidance and administration immediately following the presentation to parents and guardians. Our intention is to ensure family members at home have a good sense of what the Course Request Forms mean when their children arrive home with them.

During those presentations, we'll outline all of the course requirements for graduation for each grade level, in English, O2, and Immersion. Several courses like Math and English are pre-selected for students because they are required to graduate.

Students will take their Course Request Sheets home with them once they have received the presentation from administration and guidance. **Those forms must be returned by Friday, Feb. 23nd at 2:40 pm** in order to be included in our preliminary count of requested courses.

Should students pass them in later, the date will be noted and students will only be permitted in high-interest courses (e.g., Skilled Trades) if there is room. That is, students who passed their sheets in on time will be given first priority. While all students will remain on track to graduate, several of our elective courses have smaller class-caps and have been very popular.

TRANSCRIPTS: A reminder that any students who need transcripts MUST order them in the Guidance Office as soon as they know they need them. We can email or fax them. However, it is the student's responsibility to confirm that the institution received it. After marks are stored for reporting (February), students will need to resend their transcripts so their chosen institution will have second semester marks.

SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES: Graduating students should keep an eye on the RECA website (*reca.srce.ca*) located under the Guidance Tab, as well as the Google classroom. All opportunities sent to me are posted as they become available. It is your responsibility to apply by deadlines! Most universities have an entrance scholarship deadline in March, so please be aware of your application timeline.
